## [HB66 important info for HOMEROOM TEACHERS](#)

In order to help us be compliant with HB66, we will begin using the robocall system this Thursday. The main things I need from homeroom teachers are:

1. In your correspondence to parents, please ask them to update their Primary number, cell phone numbers and email addresses in Home Access. These all need to be listed separately in eschool in order to be identified correctly and used by the robocall system. Robocalls and emails will go out each morning when a child is marked absent with no valid reason. Their primary number is the one robocalled, then emails will go out and eventually texts will be sent to cell phones. They should also list work numbers and any other contacts in case of emergency.

If you send regular emails or newsletters, constant regular reminders probably won't hurt since numbers change pretty often.

2. Enter Attendance within 10/15 minutes of the tardy bell. Many of you do this already, thank you! If your computer is not cooperating, write down the date/teacher/students absent and lunch count then send it to the office. I will enter any tardies after the tardy bell, just be sure they have a late pass when they arrive to the classroom.
3. If you get word that a student will be absent, please let me and Anna both know as soon as possible. (forward email or send notes to the office.)
4. if parents are having trouble with Home Access, please direct them to me in the office or at 614-921-5900.

- After completing the SLO posttest, teachers will need to turn in a detailed spreadsheet to their building principal that includes:
  - Student individual names
  - Student individual pre-assessment scores
  - Student individual post-assessment scores
  - Students' individual growth target
  - Students' individual actual growth
  - If they met their target or not
- There are resources for this process in the HCSD – SLO- 2018-2019 Canvas course including:
  - Example spreadsheets
  - Fill-able spreadsheet
  - Resources for pulling data out of UNIFY if used for the assessment piece
- If you have questions about your plan and student targets, teachers can access their plan using the email from GOOGLE FORMS they were sent once the plan was submitted
  - Teachers can use the search feature in their mailbox to find the email, you would search for GOOGLE FORMS
  - All emails, even deleted emails, can be found in your email archive
