School Supply Lists

Please read the info below that Herb sent to principals regarding the process and next steps for school supply lists:

- Process for creating lists:
 - I printed every school's supply list for this school year from each building's website. My rationale for this was that this was the most recent reflection of our teachers' requests so I didn't think we needed to do a survey or a committee.
 - I tallied every item requested, how many times it showed up on grade level lists, and averaged the quantity requested for each item.
 - I removed any item off of each grade level list that wasn't requested by at least 7 buildings.
 - LaDonna priced each item using Staples.com and based off of their brand items. It's likely, but not guaranteed, that the prices for these items will be less during back-to-school season. However, since that's not a guarantee, the lists are also under \$35 in total cost.
- Building Implications:

- Keep in mind what has been shared with me when I asked Brian Wilson about our building budgets: "Each of our building's budget is funded better than 90% of schools in Ohio."
- If your grade-level teams need more for their classrooms than what we are asking parents to purchase, then you are expected to use your building funds to support their needs.
- Also, next year you will be responsible for budgeting for and ordering tissues for your building.
 - Cliff and Marcia (Cliff's secretary) will work with you to order what you need.
 - Cliff recommends that you create a budget line for this when you budget in the spring for next year.
- Remember: No "Wish Lists" of items for parents to buy for classrooms.

[Cell Phones and Electronic Devices](#)

Hi all. We have had several questions about our cell phone/electronic device policy for students. **Below is wording that I'd like you to include in communication with parents.** I will also be sending this in my weekly updates to parents. Please note that cell phones and apple watches/gizmos should be turned off and kept in a backpack during school hours. They are NOT to be out at recess. Kids are prohibited from taking pictures or video on their devices.

Electronic Devices and Cell Phones: Personal cell phones and other electronic devices such as Apple Watches should be turned off and kept secure in back packs when not being used under the supervision of an instructor. The school district is not responsible for the loss or damage of cell phones or personal electronic devices if parents elect to have their child bring one to school. Any phone or electronic device will be subject to confiscation if it creates a disruption to the academic environment. A student using an electronic device which creates a disruption or refusing to follow a reasonable request from a staff member pertaining to the phone or device may be subject to disciplinary action. Staff will be the final judge of the appropriateness of their use. Using a cellular phone or an electronic device to film/record/take pictures of any student or staff member is prohibited.
