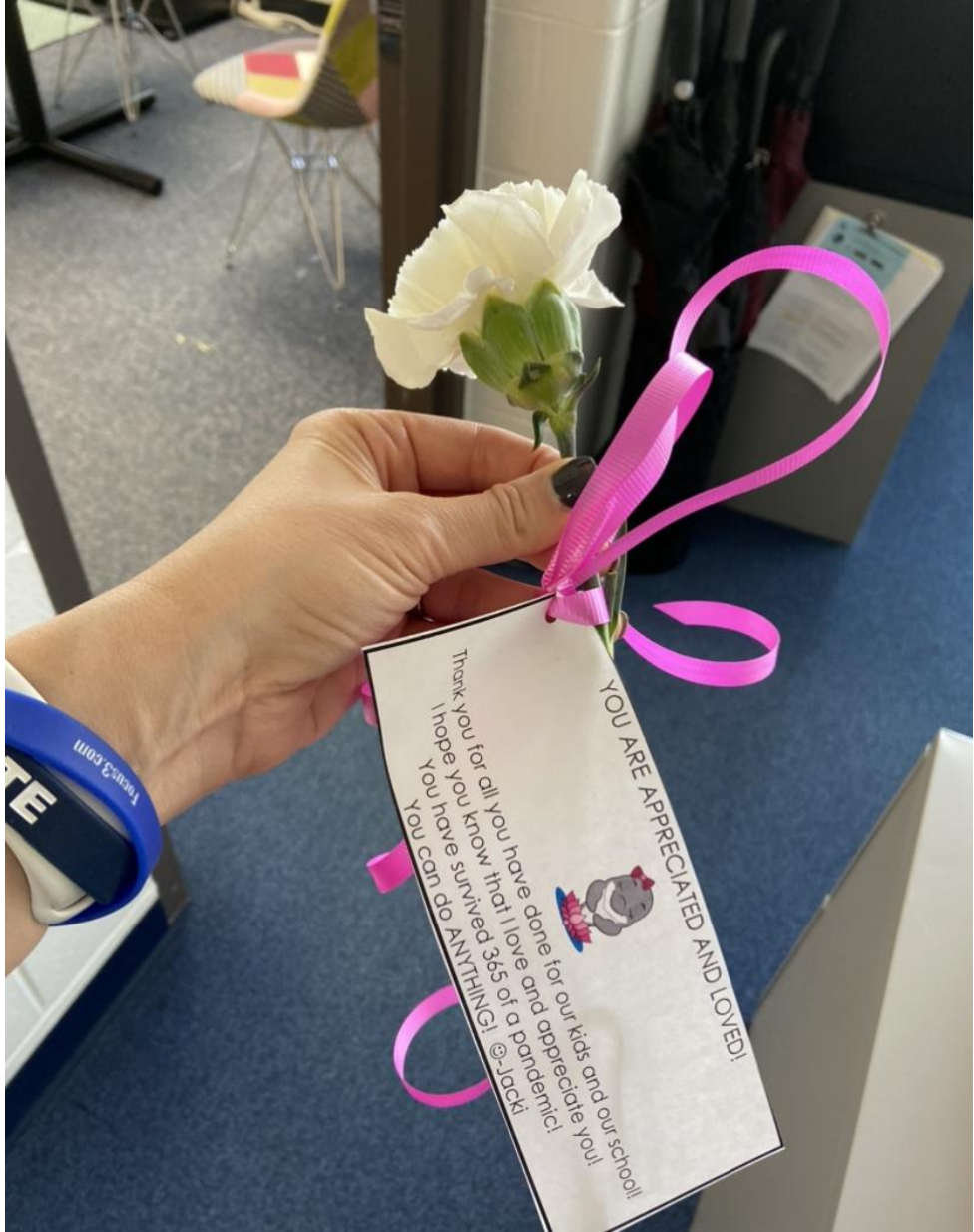
IT'S TIME FOR ALL IN TOGETHER!!

From Mark Pohlman:

I am writing to let you know that beginning on March 15, 2021 classroom teachers may begin to checkout classroom library materials to students once again! Classroom teachers MUST follow the procedures we've outlined for our media centers, however. The primary thing they must adhere to is implementing a 3-day quarantine practice for any incoming materials. It is still

recommended that students don't just freely browse through the entire collection touching as many resources as possible when they are looking to checkout a book. Encourage your teachers to display books in a manner that can help minimize multiple hands touching resources as possible.

Unfortunately, our media centers will technically remain closed and normal browsing of resources is still suspended at this time.

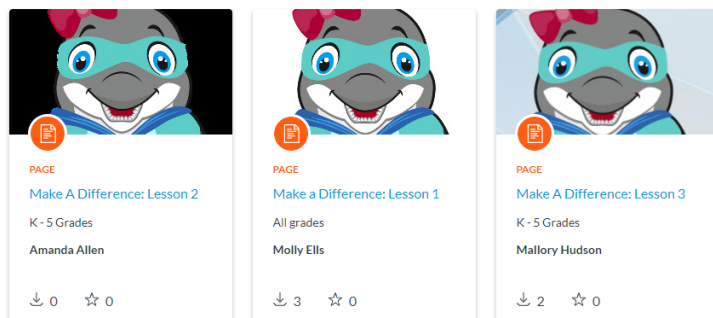
