With the biggest musical hits of the 1980's playing, you find yourself in the midst of a dance-off and suddenly stuck in time. Work together to solve all the challenges, riddles, and more before it's too late and your trapped in the 1980's forever!
- <u>Da Vinci's Lost Meatball</u>: Travel back in time to find the legendary lost meatball of the brilliant polymath Leonardo Da Vinci. Participants will have to grapple with secret passages and his mind-twisting network of pulleys and levers, but teamwork will help them through.
- <u>Trapped in a Room with a Zombie:</u> A zombie snarls in the corner, trying to break free from its chains. Together, trapped adventurers must untangle puzzles and gather clues hidden throughout the room to find the one key that grants them freedom. Every five minutes, the zombie's chains grow
