Special Education Refresher

What's the difference between tutor and modified curriculum? How do teacher responsibilities differ?

A student on a <u>modified curriculum typically sees Sarah Ferrall in the resource room but could</u> <u>see Shannon instead</u>. Why you may ask? Now that Shannon is a teacher and not a tutor she can service modified curriculum students as well as tutor students.

A student who has tutoring services will see Betty or Shannon.

If you have a student on a <u>modified curriculum</u> that means:

1-<u>Sarah or Shannon is responsible for their direct instruction</u> in either Reading, Writing or Math depending on their IEP. <u>Sarah and Shannon</u> must ensure that the student is receiving all of the accommodations listed on the IEP.

2-<u>Sarah or Shannon</u> fill out the progress report areas for these students in the areas in which they receive instruction from them. The <u>CLASSROOM TEACHER IS NOT</u> responsible for the Reading, Writing or Math if those subject areas are modified on the IEP.

3-THE CLASSROOM TEACHER IS responsible for the <u>direct instruction for SCIENCE</u>, <u>SOCIAL STUDIES</u> and <u>HEALTH/WELLNESS</u> for these students AND <u>MUST provide them will all accommodations listed</u> on the IEP.

If you have a student who is receiving tutoring services that means:

1-THE CLASSROOM TEACHER is the student's direct instructor. THE CLASSROOM TEACHER is responsible for the direct instruction in all academic areas for the student (unless there is an area that is modified).

2-THE CLASSROOM TEACHER and TUTOR MUST ensure that the student is receiving all of the accommodations listed on the IEP.

3-THE CLASSROOM TEACHER is responsible for completing all areas of the progress report.
4-The student should be able to access all general education curriculum WITH THE SUPPORT OF THE TUTOR. This can occur in a variety of ways-the tutor can pull the child out of class to reteach/provide accommodations for class work OR the tutor can push into the classroom to provide support within the general education classroom.

5-<u>THE TUTOR</u> is responsible, however, for the goals and objectives on the IEP and monitoring students' progress toward those goals, as well as working on those goals and objectives within the tutoring minutes listed on the IEP.

What if my student has basic reading on his/her IEP and it states that he or she should receive multisensory phonics instruction?

If a student on a modified curriculum OR a student who only receives tutoring services is required to receive multisensory phonics instruction, then this instruction can come from Sarah, Shannon or Betty because they all have the training.

Your challenge:

Be sure you know who is modified and who is tutor.

Also-be sure you know what accommodations that all of these students are legally obligated to receive and make sure they are always getting the accommodations.

If you have questions, please go directly to Sarah, Shannon or Betty or you can come to me. I would be happy to go through your students' IEP with you.

Duties and Related Arts
