Start preparing for March 15th

Seating in Classrooms-Michael and I will be visiting each room next week to see who needs what for all in seating.

1All In-We are going back ALL IN March 15th.

- 2-Breakfast/Lunch-This will need to be entered into TAC when we go back all in.
- 2-**3ft in classrooms-**We will need to maintain 3ft social distance in classrooms. <u>It is important to note that this means 3 feet SHOULDER TO SHOULDER not edge to edge of desk.</u> This should help

as you are arranging your rooms. YOU NEED TO GET RID OF EXTRA FURNITURE IN ORDER TO ACCOMPLISH 3 feet. We can store extra furniture in Scott Jones' room that Colleen is working in! BE SURE TO LABEL EVERYTHING YOU TAKE OUT OF YOUR ROOM.

- 3-Lunch-We will have 8 kids per table at lunch-new lunch seating charts coming soon.
- 4-Breakfast-We will be eating in the classrooms
- 5-**Dividers**-The three-sided dividers can add an extra barrier of protection. There are still a few in my office if you want to grab them. If we run out, I can request more. I suggest using them when kids eat breakfast in the rooms.
- 6-Sharing equipment-still a no and most likely never going to be a yes this school year.
- 7-Visitors in school-not this year
- 8-**5th grade clap out-**nope---5th grade teachers, I know it seems early but we will need to start thinking about doing a virtual 5th grade recognition again.
- 9-**Media Center**-plans for media center will stay the same as it is in hybrid. K and 1 pick out books from the cart. 2-5 use the Destiny system.
- 10-Quarantining-if kids are exposed to someone with COVID AT SCHOOL we will inform parents that the child will need to <u>quarantine for all activities EXCEPT for school</u>. This means if kids are exposed at school they can still come to school (as long as the child isn't experiencing symptoms). If kids are exposed outside of school then they will not be able to attend school during quarantine.
