#### **Update on Mitigation**

New mitigation practices:

1-As long as kids are **6ft AND wearing masks** then **you can take the dividers down** 

(if you have kids are at a 5ft table you need masks and one divider)

2-As long as kids are **6ft apart AND wearing masks** they can sit on the floor

3-REMEMBER----6ft and masks are CRUCIAL. Even if you have an extra divider you still need to be 6ft apart or you could end up in quarantine if the person you are 0-5 ft 11in from tests positive.
