#### **November 3-Hilliard U Day**

I'll be in touch with more information about Hilliard U as it comes available! Here is what I know now and I must say I'm pretty excited about the choice board I've created for everyone! You will be enrolled as students in this course soon! Remember staff, including secretaries DO NOT REPORT TO SCHOOL ON NOVEMBER 3! Custodians do report! You have between Nov. 1 and Nov. 8 to complete your Hilliard U work! See below:

### Welcome to a Virtual Hilliard U

Participation: This fall, Hilliard U consists of four modules that will open Sunday, November 1 and close Sunday, November 8th . Staff may choose to complete this PD on any day during this time frame, not necessarily on Tuesday, November 3rd. All Hilliard U requirements must be completed by Sunday, November 8th in order to receive credit for the day. The professional development modules are divided into Building PD, District PD, Choice PD, and Reflection. Each module has specific directions on how to complete the PD within the module. Please read how each module is set up as some modules will have choice sessions scheduled at specific times on Tuesday, November 3rd.



#### Module One: Building PD / CO

(8:00-10:00 - for any real-time activities). This module is building specific and planned by each building admin. team. Building administrators have communicated specific instructions pertaining to each building as well as linked the PD on the building page within this module. Refer to your Building Page within this module. CO staff will refer to the CO page.



#### Module Two: District PD

All staff will complete <u>three</u> required PD activities in this module: **Staff Wellness**, **Diversity** and **Equity**, and **Title IX**.

#### Module Three: Choice PD



All staff will complete <u>one</u> PD session from a **Choice Menu**. The sessions include live Zooms, pre-recorded sessions and independent activities. If a staff member doesn't find a choice session applicable, they may choose to create their own collaboration session where they would be collaborating with colleagues on anything pertaining to teaching and learning (ie. working on common assessments, planning a lesson, reviewing instructional resources, analyzing data).



#### Module Four: Reflection

All staff will complete a **google form** that will ask them to reflect on and record their participation for the day. You must complete this form in order to receive credit for participation in Hilliard U.

Requirement: Complete all four Hilliard U modules by Sunday, November 8.

#### **Book Check Out**

#### **BOOK CHECK OUT IS STARTING NOW**

We are permitted to begin having students check books out of the library. We will use the DESTINY SYSTEM for students to place books on hold and Sue will deliver the books to kids in grades 2-5. Sue will bring book displays to K and 1 for kids to choose from without touching books. The books will be quarantined after they are returned. We will begin allowing kids to place books on hold as soon as you are able to get them going with Destiny.

Things to remember-

Kids can place up to 4 books on hold.

Kids can check out 2 books at a time.

Kids CAN browse the books on Destiny and place holds at home or at school.

Kindergarten and 1st grade will use book displays

Here is the video from Kelly Riley that will walk YOU AND YOUR STUDENTS through using Destiny! I would really, really prefer that you get onto this video this week so they can get books next week!

### **Rapid Evacuation Drill Coming in November**

On November 9th or 10th we will be having a RAPID EVACUATION DRILL! For this drill I will be joined by the Hilliard Police Department. We will make an announcement asking you to exit the building as if we were running from a threat.

Please practice a rapid exit with your students. Remember:

Teach them to run out of the building without pushing, etc.

Teach them to stop at a designated spot AND POINT TO WHERE THEY WOULD GO IF THIS WAS REAL AND THEY NEEDED TO GET AWAY FROM THE SCHOOL FAST!

Some things we say to kids are:

- -If there was a gas leak and we had to run away from our school fast we would.....
- -One time, Mrs. Prati propped the door open and a racoon got in the school, we had to run out of the building FAST. Where would you go if YOU had to run out of the building.

Have these discussions with kids and then please practice.

#### F and P Due Dates
