We thought that this would be a fun way to celebrate our kids who are always striving to be above the line! The team brainstormed a bit on what we will do each month for these students, but we wanted to give freedom to the teachers to decide how the students are chosen.

What we were thinking:

- 3-5 students each month are chosen to represent a class as a R Factor Student of the Month (Once again the exact amount is up to the discretion of the teacher!)
- Each month you would have a different goal to choose the R Factor Student of the Month. For example, one month you might choose to celebrate the students who get the most Dolly stickers throughout the month, another month you may choose to have students nominate each other to choose the Students of the Month. We wanted to leave this open-ended so that teachers (who know their kids the best) could decide who to celebrate that particular month! Please just make sure again, just like the Dolly sticker, that the kids know why they were chosen and are able to talk about the why!
