## Gifted Referral

I know that it is early, but there is a MAP-Math gifted testing window with a referral deadline of 9/27/21 coming up! The testing will occur 10/4-10/20. If you are seeing students with unmet needs in Math, please refer them by the deadline for gifted testing! I will have gifted referral sheets in my mailboxes in all 3 schools, and you can also retrieve a form from the district website under gifted referral form. In addition, STAR READING IS ON THE ODE APPROVED TESTING LIST AS AN IDENTIFIER for this year (95\%ile and above)! STAR Math will still need to be referred for further
testing. Please make a copy of the Gifted Testing Calendar linked above so that you are aware of the further deadlines for referrals on each testing window.
Please notice that there is only one CogAT (verbal, quantitative, and nonverbal assessment) testing window. Also, continue to refer students showing mastery in any area! Thank you.

## Hispanic Heritage Month

Hispanic Heritage month is September 15- October 15. We would like to celebrate this important month, just like we did Black History Month.

## Why?
