New Fire Drill Procedures

Please REMIND STUDENTS ABOUT ORDERLY EVACUATIONS

Our safety drill was great so now we are going to revamp our fire drill procedures. We need you to train your students to do the following when they hear the fire alarm:

- 1. Leave the room as soon as they hear the alarm. Do not line up and wait for a teacher!
- 2. NO HOLDING THE DOOR
- 3. When students get outside they will then find their class and stand in line so teachers can take attendance.
- 4. If students are with speech or title or ELL teachers or library etc they DO NOT NEED TO RUN AND FIND THEIR CLASSROOM TEACHER!!! They need to find the teacher who they were with when the fire drill went off.
