# **Evacuation Drill**

#### REMIND YOUR STUDENT TO BE SILENT DURING AN EVACUATION!!!!

Here are a few things we discussed with all of you and your classes regarding "RUN" evacuation drills.

Kindergarten, there are still 2 classes we need to get with. We will come by tomorrow or Wednesday.

- 1. Discuss Evacuation Drill with each grade level.
  - -Why would we need to evacuate?
  - -How will you know when to evacuate/when to RUN? Discuss various locations they may be at
  - in the building. (Lunch, Specials, etc....)
  - -How do we RUN/exit the building. (Not holding doors, Not lining up, walking/running quickly

Not running over people, go out windows if you can) Let them know what they SHOULD do

instead.

- -What exit/door do we run out of? How will we know?
- -Where do we run to?
- -How far/long should we run?
- 2. Do a WALK-THROUGH. Walk through and discuss as we go. Take kids outside to see what options they might regarding where to run. Identify places to run.
- 3. Practice a PRACTICE DRILL. Give the signal "RUN"....and let students go. For the PRACTICE DRILL we can identify a place for them to run to. (Baseball diamond, Gaga Pit....etc)
- 4. Have teachers discuss how the drill went with individual classes giving them a Q&A time. (LET STUDENTS ALSO KNOW THAT WE WILL BE DOING THIS SAME TYPE OF EVACUATION DRILL (walking quickly, not running) DURING FIRE DRILLS, with the exception of lining up outside with their class).
- 5. As a grade level, try to practice together twice a week.

Just wanted to let you all know that we are having the kids "RUN" when it is evacuation only. During a Fire Drill, the kids are NOT lining up, and walking quickly, NOT a full out run. Also, we want to be sure that you guys practice the Hide (barricade) and Fight (identifying objects to throw).

# **Medical Alert**

While on field trips, students who take daily medication at school and/or have emergency medications *must be grouped with their teacher or other staff member*. The medication must, at all times, accompany the student for prompt access, as needed. Parent volunteers cannot be responsible for these medications. The only exception to this is if the student is grouped with their own parent or guardian, who would then be responsible for carrying and administering the medication.

Teachers with students who have daily/emergency medications need to have taken the medication training module, which can be found on Canvas. If you have any questions or need to review any medication administration procedures, please see the School Nurse.

This year you will circle if the student is **gifted, high average, at, low average, or far below average**.

This is for academics ONLY!

If a child is **high average** in reading but is considered **at** for math then I would circle **at.** We will know based on the F and P level how to instruct that child as a reader. We need to think about how the child performs overall academically. Go with your gut and don't over think it. The same scenario would go for math high average but at for reading. Also consider writing, for example if they are a high average reader but only at for writing then that is important to take into account. Also, any clarification can be explained in the comments. We are really trying to avoid having a huge range of needs to instruct in the classroom. If we cluster appropriately we have closer instructional bands and it will make it more manageable to meet and grow all of our students.
