STAR TESTING

It's hard to believe, but our second STAR testing window is right around the corner!! Below are some updates and reminders to ensure your testing goes well!!

- Ø The 2nd Testing window will open on <u>November 14</u>th! Please plan to have your testing completed by <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>November 22nd</u> that will allow you November 28-30th for make-ups. It is very important that we test students within this window so that their data will be there for certain reports in STAR as well as in eSchool, and Performance Matters. The testing that happens between the windows for progress monitoring is not captured in these other spots. So <u>please</u> <u>make every effort to test earlier in the window allowing time for all of the exceptions that come along!</u>
- Ø Remember that **ALL students in the district are given the same accommodations** of extended time on the Reading as well as both extended time and Audio for the math.
- Ø Reminder that extended time does NOT mean unlimited time, so be sure you prepare your students for the fact that they will time out on certain questions. When the little clock pops up, it's time to either pick an answer, or let it go and move on to the next question. Remember that every student is guaranteed to miss multiple questions, that's how the system figures out the students' limits.

If you leave the building
