- **Staff Referral Data** being organized and developed for individual and group counseling. Please expect notes to go home in the near future for parent permission
- Counseling Data the data I collect will work with your data and help develop a plan of action for our areas of immediate need
- Classroom Guidance Lessons our teacher survey will be sent out next week and the classroom visits, based upon your presenting needs, will be analyzed and developed
- **Student Self-Referrals** continue to meet with our strong student self-referral needs and attend to specific problems on a day-to-day basis

#### **Points of Focus:**

- Our student need is very high right now. We know these things because of your referral data you are all rock stars!
- The second classroom visits will be put on hold in order to organize our immense about of referral data. Your second classroom visit will be based upon your area of need from your survey.
- Syntero and I will begin to make counseling groups and start more intensive individual counseling sessions
